- 1. Apologies and reasons for absence** were received from District Councillor Vincent Fitzpatrick and Councillor Steffan Aquarone and Councillor Elaine Bennett
- 2. No Declarations of Interests and Request for Dispensations were declared**
- 3. The minutes of the meeting held on the 8th November 2022 were agreed & signed as true record**
- 4. Matters arising from minutes and not on the agenda**
 - 4.1** Coastal Community Shop has now been running a month and they are in need of some volunteers
 - 4.2** Bus stop has been announced and an installation date of 13/14th February has been pencilled in.
- 5. Update from District and County Councillors**
 - 5.1.** *District Councillor* Vincent Fitzpatrick had circulated his update in advance
 - 5.2.** *County Councillor* Steffan Aquarone had circulated his update in advance
 - 5.3.** Both reports have been published on the Stibbard website and Facebook page
- 6. Public Participation** – no members of the public were present
- 7. To discuss / respond correspondence received**
 - 7.1** An email had been received from the Stibbard Ditch Warden about the stream that runs along the Wood Norton Road. Cllr Coomber is going to meet with the warden to discuss further.
 - 7.2** There has been a complaint about the amount of mud produced by the farm traffic in Moor End. It was noted that the Parish Council do not have any powers over the highways so it was best for the complainant to speak to Highways and the farmer directly.

10.2 Village logo The Parish Council logo designed by Cllr Coomber was agreed. The village sign was discussed and agreed the village school could be involved in designing elements of the sign.

10.3 Footpaths no more possible footpaths have been found

11. **Grass Cutting** it was agreed that TOPS Garden Services are to be appointed for this year and £250 donation to the church towards their grass cutting costs

12. **Projector and screen** Councillor Richards is going to explore the possibility of a wheel out TV screen from his work to be used for PC meetings and left at the Village Hall for everyone to use.

13. **Financial matters** financial statement agreed and a total of £352.00 plus clerk's fortnightly wage is to be paid.

14. **Precept and budget planning** the Council looked at the budget for the rest of the financial year and the projected costs for 2023/24 and the precept was unanimously agreed at £12,343.

15. **Any other Business**

15.1 War Memorial it was agreed the War Memorial does need a specialist clean this year and every other year (if required) and the costs approved
