This adjustment in the precept will inevitably have an impact on your local council tax. While we understand the financial implications this may have for residents, we want to assure you that this decision was made with the long-term sustainability and well-being of our community in mind.

The additional funds generated through this increase will be dedicated to addressing pressing needs, improving local infrastructure, and ensuring that Stibbard continues to be a thriving and vibrant place to live.

In practical terms, for tax bands B and D, the annual increase would amount to £37.05 per year equating to an additional £3.09 per month.
